



Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Period of poorer stability overnight as snow turns to rain and the freezing level rises above summits. Most affected areas will be steep North-West through North to North-East aspects above 950 metres. Some localised surface instability on steepest East to South-East aspects above the same altitude. Small but wet and weak cornices. General improvement in stability in all locations much later in the day. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight snow showers turning to rain at all levels from dawn. Strong South-East winds. Initially cold but freezing level rising quickly to 2000 metres before dawn.

Comments

Better stability later on Thursday.
