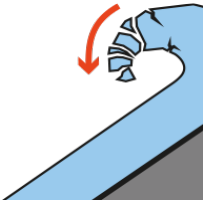

Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow cover, with deepest areas above 900 metres, will continue to thaw and consolidate at all levels. Isolated wet snow instabilities will persist on very steep terrain. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

Forecast Weather Influences

Remaining mild with occasional rain during the day. Winds, light Easterlies at dawn but strengthening to become moderate Southerlies.

Comments

The snow continues to thaw and consolidate. One avalanche noted, probably from yesterday.
