

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 18/03/2023


Avalanche Problems



Cornices

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to slowly thaw and consolidate at all levels, and be generally stable. Remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will remain above all summits. After a dry night, light rain is expected during the day, especially through the afternoon, when some sleet or wet snow is possible on the highest summits. Winds will be light East-South-Easterly overnight, strengthening to be moderate to strong South-Easterly during the day and veering South-Westerly during the afternoon.

Comments

In these thaw conditions falling ice is an additional hazard.
