


## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

### Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 19/03/2023

#### Avalanche Problems

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow will be well consolidated and stable. Low level snow will continue to slowly thaw. The snow on the very highest mountains will gradually start to firm up, especially along the Northern boundary of the area. The most extensive snow will be encountered above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation. Fresh North-Westerly winds overnight, easing during the day as they back, to become light South-Westerly. Freezing level lowering to 900 metres overnight and then fluctuating around 1100 metres during the day.

#### Comments

Wet snow firming up on the main Cairngorm summits - 900 metre approx freezing level.
