
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The existing wet snowpack will refreeze above 900 metres. Fresh areas of unstable windslab will develop during the day. Greatest accumulations will be on steep North, North-East and East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Rain at all levels overnight being replaced with snow above 800 metres early on Wednesday. Strong South-Westerly winds over the summits.
