




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in wind sheltered areas, mainly on North-West through North to East aspects above 900 metres. Accumulations gaining depth will increase and become more extensive. Newly formed cornices will be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be generally Southerly, strong during the evening and moderate to strong from midnight onwards. The freezing level will be around 800 metres gradually rising to 1000 metres during the day. Showers throughout the period will fall as snow mainly above 800 metres.
