




Wind Slab

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Fresh unstable windslab will continue to be deposited in wind sheltered locations. Areas most affected will be steep North-West through North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Newly formed cornices will be fragile. The older snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Scattered showers will fall as snow above around 800 metres until mid morning and above around 1000 metres later in the day. Fresh South-South-Easterly winds overnight becoming moderate South-South-Westerly during the day. The freezing level will rise to around 1100 metres.

**Comments**

Some uncertainty in snowfall amounts. Colder conditions forecast for Saturday and Sunday.
