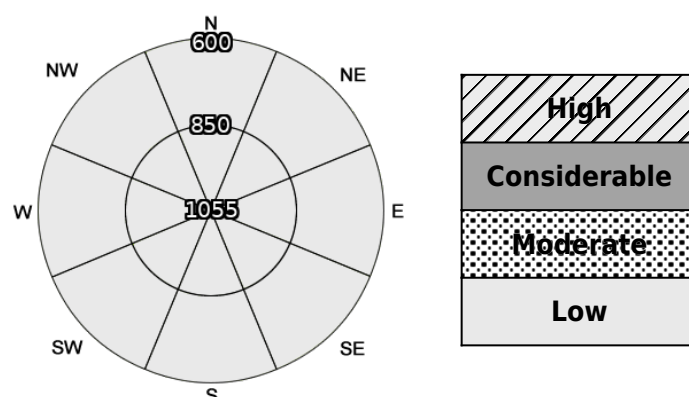


**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW****Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 24/03/2023****Avalanche Problems****Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The existing shallow snow cover will start to gradually thaw and consolidate in the mild conditions. Any remaining old snow patches will be well bonded and stable. Greatest cover will be found in North through East to South-East aspects above 850 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.

**Forecast Weather Influences**

Mainly dry with only a few light showers overnight, falling as snow on the highest summits. Moderate southerly winds ease with the freezing level around 1000 metres.
