




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New weak windslab development expected during the day on steep North to East aspects above 950m. Gully exits and the top of steep coire backwalls will be the most affected locations. New weak cornices. Better stability at lower elevations and on less steep ground. Good stability where the old snowpack is exposed and wind-scoured. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



Forecast Weather Influences

Sleety light snow showers overnight becoming more persistent for a time during the day. Freezing near summits overnight then cooler during the day. Fresh South-South-Easterly winds easing and becoming Southerly then South Westerly later.
