

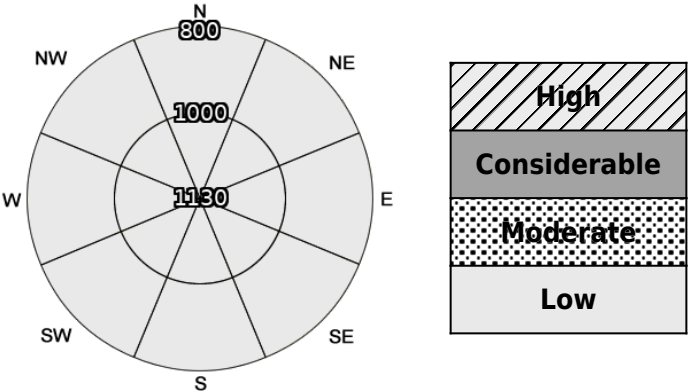

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Saturday 25/03/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will refreeze as the temperature drops and stability will be good. Fresh windslab accumulations, mainly on South to West aspects above 1000 metres, are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate to fresh North-East winds. Light showers overnight falling as snow above around 800 metres. The freezing level will drop from summit level to around 700 metres.

Comments

Some uncertainty in forecast snow amounts with the East of the area likely to receive the most.
