

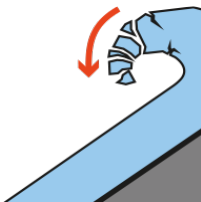

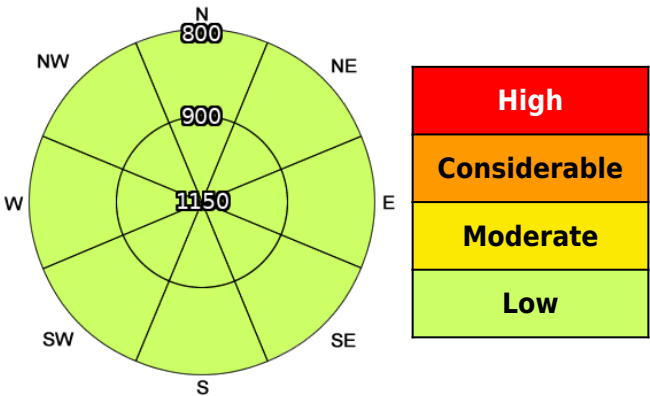

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Much of the existing snow be firm with the continuing colder conditions. Stability will generally remain good on all but the steepest slopes affected by solar warming where shallow surface instabilities will remain a possibility, cornices will also be suspect in these areas. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

It will remain dry, clear and with variable moderate to fresh winds. The freezing level by morning will be around 300 metres rising through the course of the day to 700 metres.

Comments

Sunny and fairly calm conditions forecast. Exposed slopes at higher elevations may be firm and icy.
