
Avalanche Problems



Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A period of localised instability during the afternoon with the onset of rain and milder temperatures. Most affected areas will be steep North-West to North-East facing coire rims and gully tops above 950 metres. Better stability in all other locations. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers during the morning followed by rain at all levels during the afternoon. Strong South-South-East winds. Initially cold but much milder at all altitudes from midday.
