



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 29/03/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The patchy snow cover will be well bonded and stable with surface layers softening in the milder conditions, especially at lower elevations. More extensive areas of snow will be encountered above 900 metres, most frequently on the high mountains of the main Cairngorm plateau. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing levels are expected to be above the summits. Dry overnight but light rain throughout the day. Winds will mostly be South-South-East, moderate becoming fresh in the afternoon.

Comments

Only light new snowfall today (Tuesday), wet tomorrow all levels.
