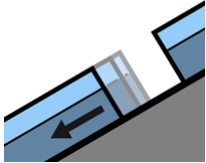

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Friday 31/03/2023

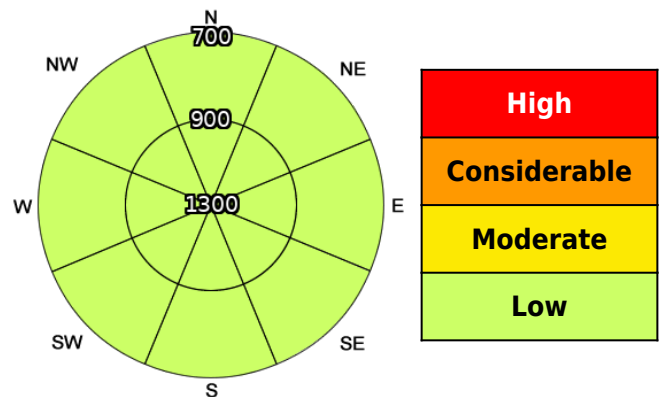
Avalanche Problems



Gliding Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate at all altitudes. There will be potential for some minor surface instabilities in isolated steep and convex locations on North-West to North-East aspects above 1000 metres, but in general the snowpack will be well bonded and stable throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry, mild conditions expected throughout the forecast period. Fresh to strong winds will be generally South-Easterly in direction. The freezing level will remain above the summits.
