

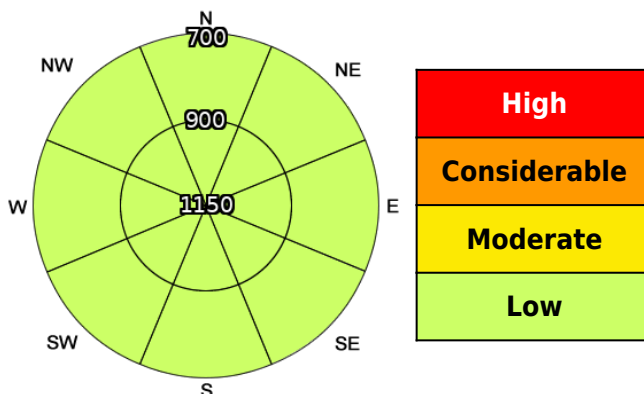

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining patchy snow will continue to thaw at all levels but remain well bonded and stable. Greatest amounts will be encountered above 900 metres, especially on the higher mountains of the main Cairngorm plateau area. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A cloudy dry day is expected. The freezing level will be above the summits. Winds, mostly Easterly, moderate in strength.
