

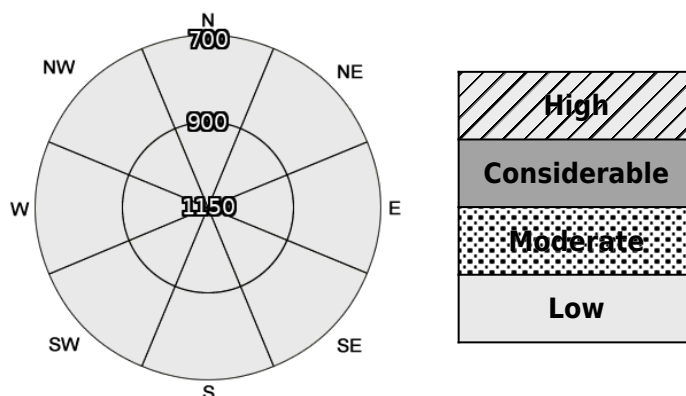

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface layers of the old patchy snow will be firm first thing, softening slightly at lower elevations by the end of the day. Deposits will be well bonded and stable throughout. Largest areas of old snow will be found above 900 metres, especially in steep wind sheltered locations on North to East aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation has been forecast. Light East, veering Southerly winds. 750 metre freezing level overnight, rising to 1150 metres by the end of the period.
