


THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Sunday 02/04/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. New snow amounts are not expected to be significant. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light, variable, but generally Southerly winds. A little precipitation overnight will fall as snow above around 1000 metres. The freezing level will be around 1200 metres.

Comments

Greatest snow cover in high North and East facing corries and gullies. Although not very likely, cornice collapse remains a possibility. One reported today and debris observed from one that collapsed earlier in the week.
