

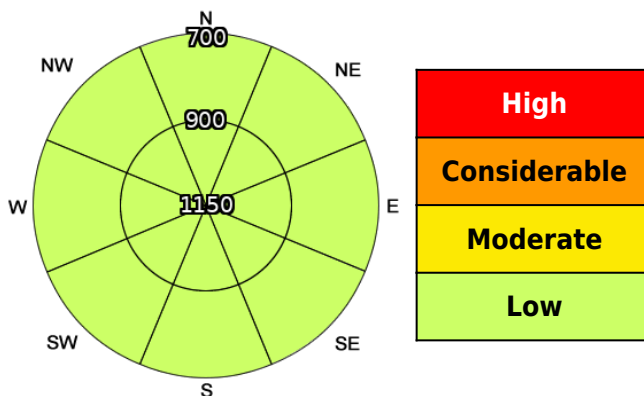

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 03/04/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The surface layers of the patchy snow will firm up overnight becoming hard and icy: Gradually softening at lower elevations during the day. All deposits will be well bonded and stable. Largest areas will be encountered in wind sheltered locations on mainly North to East aspects above 900 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Ridge of high pressure developing, giving dry conditions with a night frost. Sub-zero temperatures at 930 metres overnight rising to plus two degrees centigrade by mid-afternoon. Light South-Easterly winds overnight becoming moderate Southerlies during the day.

Comments

Old snow will be very firm first thing after an overnight refreeze.
