



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 03/04/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will remain well bonded and stable. The surface will become firm above around 1000 metres with a slow thaw continuing at lower elevations. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Moderate South-East winds will become strong by dawn and veer Southerly during the day. It is expected to remain dry. Freezing above around 1000 metres.

Greatest snow cover in high North and East facing corries and gullies.
