

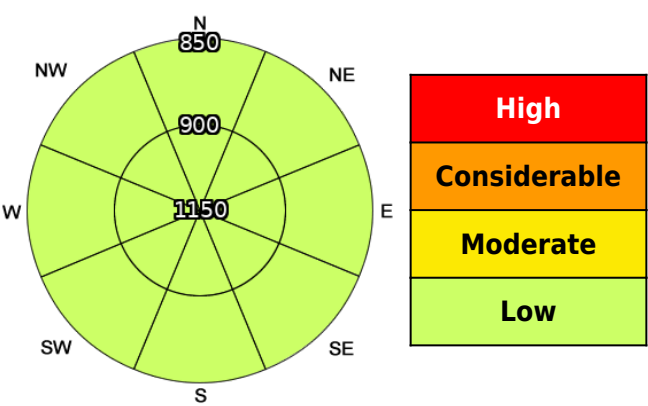

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Monday 03/04/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The limited snowpack, which mainly exists in the higher North and East facing corries will be firm on the highest slopes initially, softening through the day as temperatures rise. There will be generally good stability throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Dry conditions will affect the area overnight and through Monday. Winds will be fresh, generally Southerly. Summit temperatures will be around -1 centigrade initially, rising to + 1 through the course of the day.

Comments

Remaining dry for next 48 hours with strong South-South-Westerly winds developing later in the period.
