

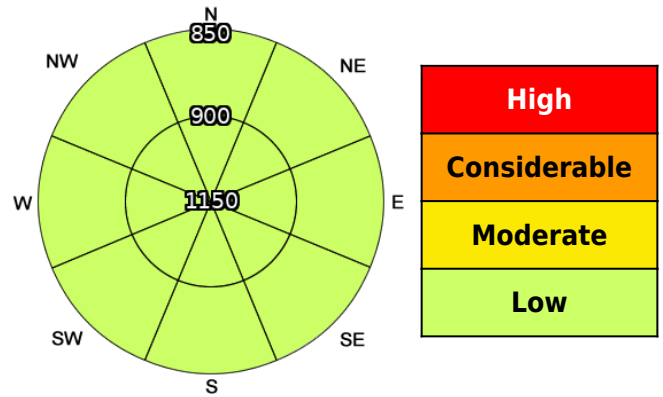
**THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE LOW**

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 04/04/2023**

**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

The limited snowpack, which mainly exists in the higher North and East facing corries will be firm on the highest slopes initially, softening through the day as temperatures rise. Snowpack stability will be generally good throughout. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

Dry conditions will affect the area overnight and through Tuesday. Winds will be generally Southerly, fresh occasionally strong. Summit temperatures will be around -1 centigrade initially, rising to + 1 through the course of the day.

**Comments**

Becoming more unsettled with some heavy rain possible by Wednesday.
