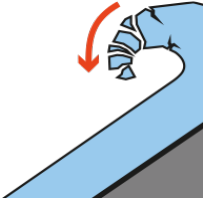

**Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 05/04/2023**

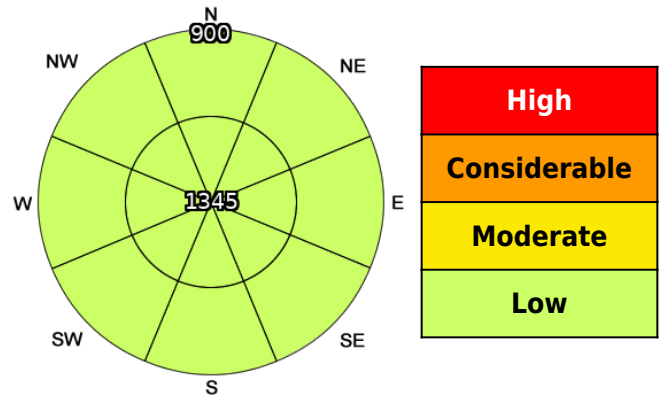
**Avalanche Problems**

**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

There will be little change in the snowpack. It will be stable and well bonded. The surface layers will soften in the rain and rising temperatures as the day progresses, with any remaining cornices becoming less stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

There will be some overnight rain, with sleet on the highest summits. During the day there will be light rain and drizzle to all levels. The freezing level will be above the summits throughout the period. On the tops, winds will be mainly Southerly easing from very strong overnight to fresh by the end of Wednesday.
