

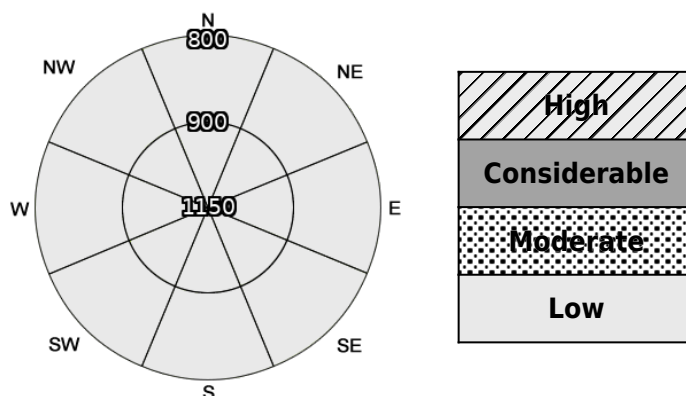

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The remaining patchy snow will continue to slowly thaw at all levels but will remain well bonded and stable. Greatest amounts will be encountered above 900 metres in North to East corries and around the higher Cairngorm tops. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

A cloudy but dry day is expected with the freezing level above the summits. Winds strengthening becoming fresh South-South-Easterlies.
