

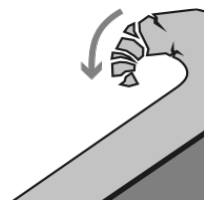

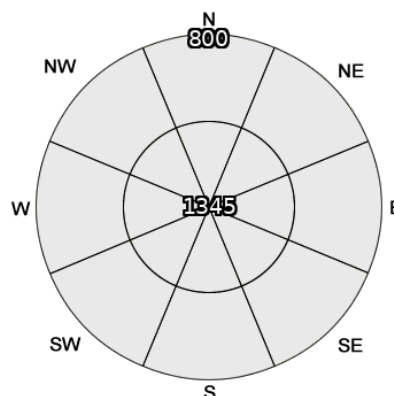

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poor stability on North West through North to East aspects above 850 metres. New weak windslab build expected overnight and during the day. Most affected areas will be steep coire backwalls and gully tops. New weak cornice development anticipated over steepest lee slopes. Better stability on all other aspects, less steep ground and lower altitudes. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

Persistent, heavy snow showers. Cold summit temperatures. Strong East-South-East winds during the evening, veering South-South-Westerly, then backing South-South-Easterly during the morning .
