

Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 13/04/2023


Avalanche Problems



Persistent Weak Layers

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Areas of unstable windslab will be present, mainly on slopes sheltered from Wednesday's South-Westerly winds. Greatest accumulations will be on North, North-East and East aspects above 900 metres, notably where it overlies older snow accumulations. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers above 700 metres will continue throughout the period. Winds will decrease overnight and become light to moderate from a Westerly direction in the afternoon.

Winds easing for Thursday but unstable fresh snow accumulations remaining
