

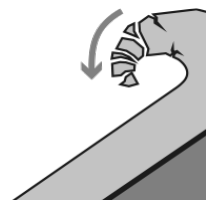

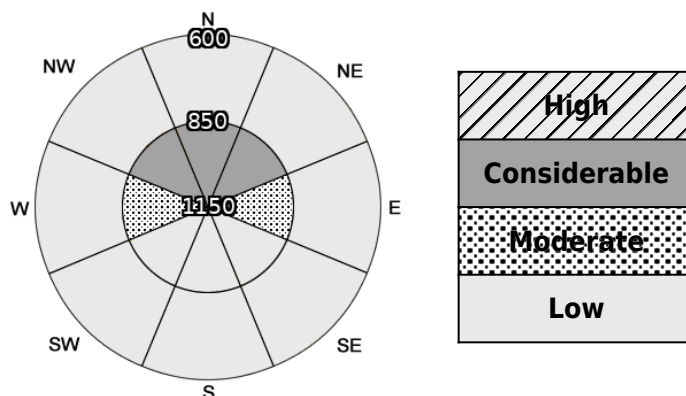
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will be present in wind sheltered locations on North-West to North-East aspects above 850 metres. Moderately bonded deposits on West and East aspects. Fragile cornices will be present above these aspects. Elsewhere the snow will be shallow and insignificant. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snowfall during the evening above 600 metres, followed by light snow showers overnight and during the day above 700, then 800 metres. Moderate Easterly winds overnight, backing and easing to become light North-Westerly. 700 metre freezing level overnight, rising to 1100 metres by mid-afternoon.

Comments

Uncertainty on snow amounts: Could be between 5 to 10cm; small likelihood of 20cm.
