
Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Marginally stable snow will exist in steepest, mostly North to Easterly aspect above 900 metres. Greatest accumulations will be in steep, sheltered gully tops on North West through to Easterly aspects. The existing snowpack elsewhere will continue to consolidate. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Mainly dry overnight with further wintry showers during the day above 800 metres. Light South-Westerly winds.
