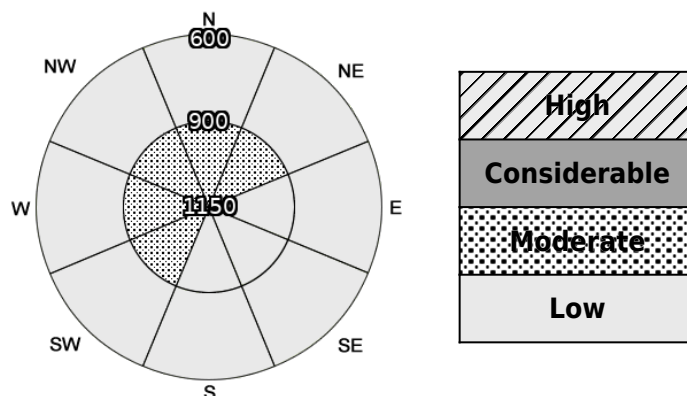
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be some consolidation of existing deposits but localised moderately bonded windslab will persist, mainly on South-West through North-West to North-East above 900 metres. Steep wind sheltered locations such as gully tops and corrie rims will be most affected. Any new snow will have little effect on overall stability. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Generally dry overnight but light snow showers developing above 900 metres during the afternoon. Winds will be mostly light Southerly.

Comments

Deep snow in sheltered locations. Slow going at times.
