

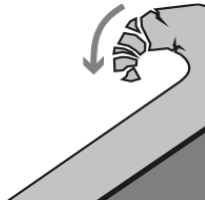

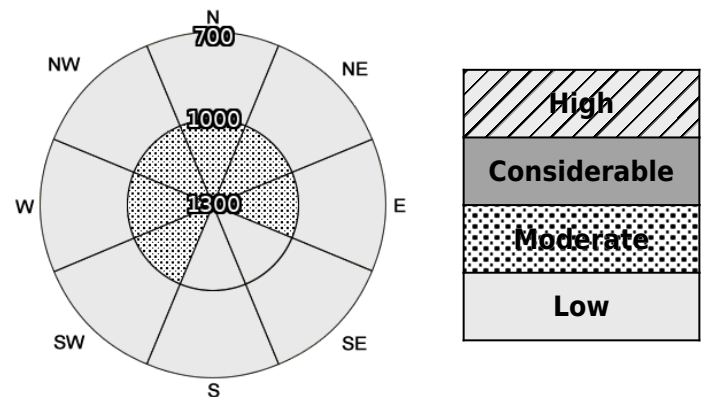
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate at all altitudes. Localised instabilities will remain present above 1000 metres on South-West through North to East aspects. Areas most affected will be in steep and convex terrain such as around coire rims and gully tops. Above these aspects cornices will be fragile and prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers will peter out during the early evening. Moderate Southerly winds will increase to strong through the day. Long spells of sunshine expected. The freezing level will rise from 1000 metres to above the summits by midday.
