

Wind Slab





**Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard**

Remaining instabilities in recent windslab accumulations will consolidate through the period. Areas most affected will be gullies and coire rims with a North to East aspect above around 1150 metres. Wet snow surface instabilities possible on steep slopes exposed to the sun. Cornices in the sun will be prone to collapse. Elsewhere snowpack stability will be generally good. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



**Forecast Weather Influences**

A dry sunny day. Light Southerly winds will increase in strength to moderate. The freezing level will rise above the summits during the afternoon.

**Comments**

High pressure building, bringing settled and mild conditions over the weekend.
