

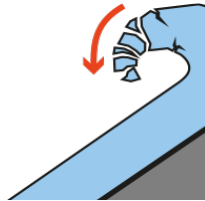
## THE AVALANCHE HAZARD WILL BE MODERATE

#### Avalanche Problems



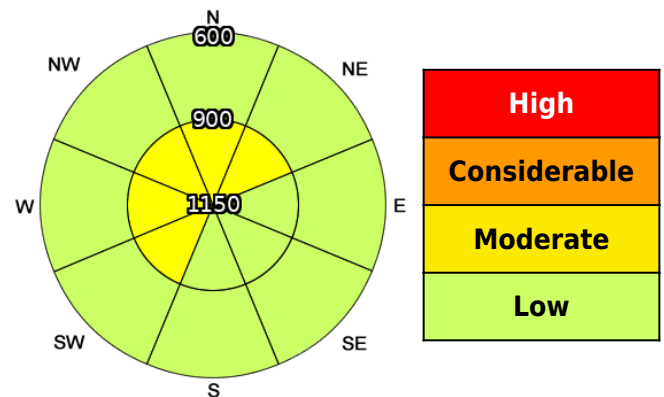
Wind Slab

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate but moderately bonded windslab will persist on South-West through North-West to North-East aspects above 900 metres. Steep wind sheltered terrain such as gully tops and corrie rims most affected. Cornice stability will remain suspect. Localised deeper drifts will be encountered from 750 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



#### Forecast Weather Influences

After a brief snow shower this evening, dry throughout the rest of the period. The freezing level will initially be around 900 metres but will rise above the summits during the day. Winds light overnight, East at dawn, veering and strengthening to become moderate Southerlies.
