



Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate. Snowpack stability will be generally good. Isolated surface instabilities possible and cornices will be prone to collapse, particularly where in the sun. Greatest snow accumulations will remain in high North and East facing corries. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

After a few overnight showers that will fall as rain at most levels, it will be a dry overcast day. Winds will be moderate Southerly. The freezing level will be above the summits.
