




Wet Snow

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Some overnight wet snow instabilities will coincide with the arrival of any rain on recent snow deposits above 950 metres. These in highest, steepest North-West to Easterly aspects. After some transitional instability, the remaining snowpack in all locations will continue to consolidate in steady slow, thaw conditions. Any recent new cornices above these aspects will be suspect. Good stability at all lower elevations and aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The Strong Southerly winds will moderate overnight with the arrival of some light rain and drizzle. A cloudy, overcast but mostly dry day is then expected. The Freezing Level will remain well above summits throughout.

Comments

Last report of the season.

In thaw conditions cornices remain suspect around coire rims with the additional hazard of rockfall below crag faces. Have a good summer.
