

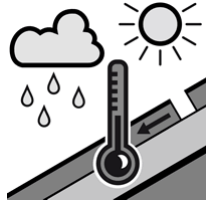

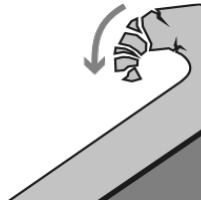

Wind Slab



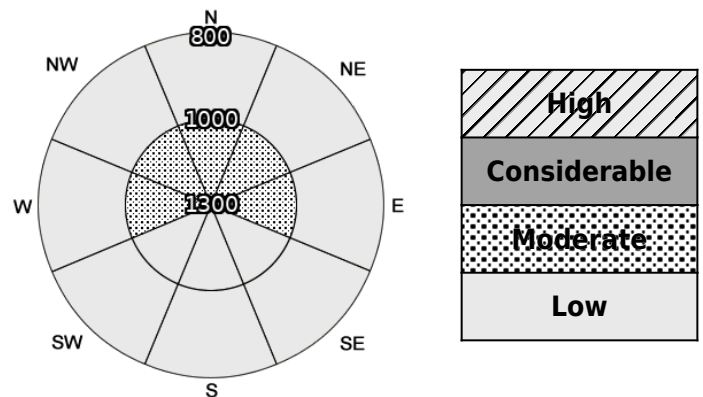

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate on all aspects and at all levels. Localised instabilities will persist in the recently deposited windslab, mainly on West through North to East aspects above 1000 metres. Cornices above these aspects will be prone to collapse. Some surface wet snow instabilities are possible on steep slopes during the day. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

It is expected to be dry throughout the period, with the freezing level above the summits. Winds will be generally Southerly, gale force overnight and moderate to strong during the day.
