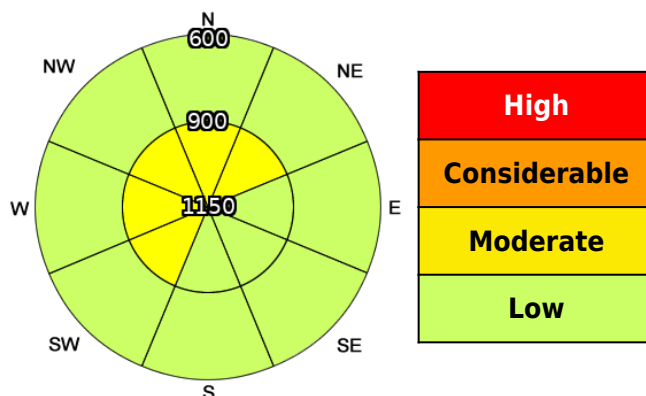
Avalanche Problems



Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The majority of the snow will be soft but generally stable with consolidation continuing to take place in the milder conditions. Localised accumulations of moderately bonded snow will persist in a few steeper, wind sheltered locations on South-West through North-West to North-East aspects above 1000 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

No precipitation forecast. Moderate Southerly winds, easing to become light during the late afternoon. Cooler overnight, then the air temperature will warm up during the day with the freezing level well above the summits.
