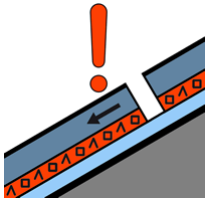


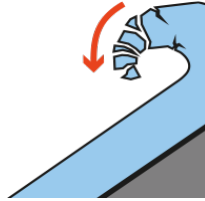

#### Avalanche Problems



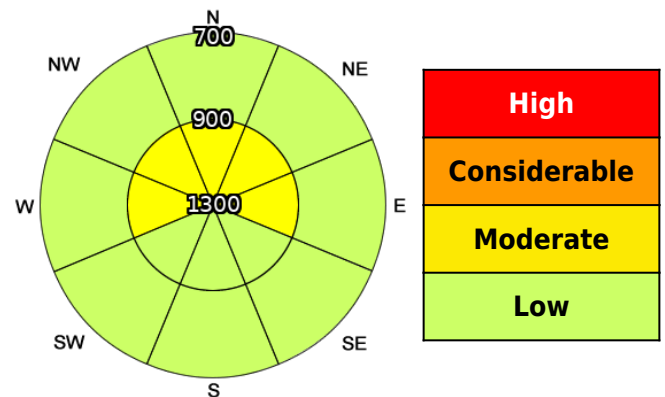
Persistent Weak Layers

#### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to consolidate and stabilise in the mild conditions. However, weaknesses will continue to persist in the deeper deposits which mostly lie in wind sheltered lee slopes above 900m on West through North to East aspects. Coire rims, back walls, gully tops and crag aprons being most affected. Any remaining cornices will be prone to collapse. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate



#### Forecast Weather Influences

Little change is expected. The Freezing level will be around 12-1400m. Winds will be fresh South-Easterly. Precipitation will fall as sleet and drizzle on the highest summits rain or drizzle below.

#### Comments

Generally improving conditions. Debris from a very large natural avalanche observed on a NW facing slope at 1100m which is likely to have released on the 7th. Mild conditions persisting through the weekend.
