

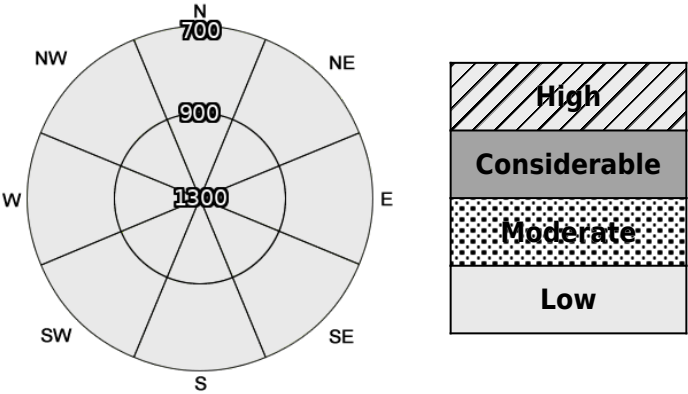

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Little change is expected, greatest accumulations of snow lie on West through North to Easterly aspects above 950m and although moist to depth will be generally stable throughout. Below this level snow cover is patchy, soft, but stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low



Forecast Weather Influences

Freezing level above the summits, lowering to 900m or so late in the day. Precipitation overnight will be light rain with sleet on summits.

Comments

Mild conditions. Stonefall noted below crags. A cooler outlook and becoming colder mid week.
