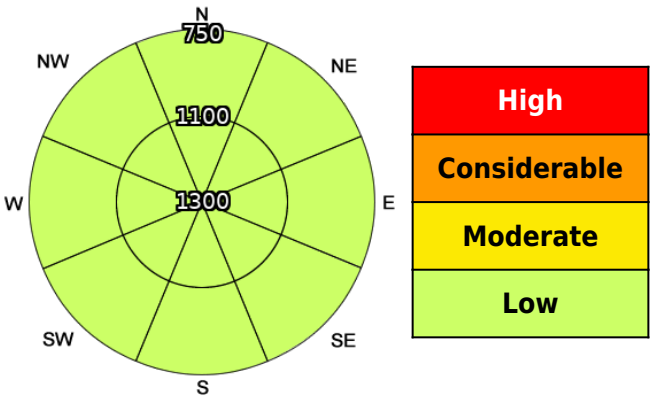

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

The snowpack will continue to thaw and consolidate at all levels. Some isolated instabilities will persist within very steep terrain on North-West to North-East aspects above 1100 metres. On these aspects cornices will prone to collapse. Elsewhere the snowpack will be generally well bonded and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale to storm force South-Westerly winds. Precipitation throughout the forecast period, this will fall as light rain and drizzle at all levels. The freezing level will remain above the summits.

Comments

Mild, damp, windy conditions expected over the weekend. Turning cooler again on Monday.
