


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 19/12/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of light snow deposits are not expected to be significant, these will fall onto moist bare ground and should not present an avalanche hazard. Greatest accumulations will be on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres.



Forecast Weather Influences

Tonight colder conditions, a showery West to North-West flow will become established and the freezing level will be around 800 metres. Showers will fall as snow mainly above 650 metres with severe gale or storm force Westerly winds, gusts reaching 60 to 70 mph.

Comments

Storm force winds with white out conditions can be expected.
