


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Tuesday 19/12/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Currently there is insufficient snow cover to present any avalanche hazard and avalanche reports will not be issued for this area. Go to the Blogs and Mountain info for area photos; area info will be provided by SAIS forecasters on a daily basis.



Forecast Weather Influences

Strong increasing very strong, generally Westerly winds. During the evening the freezing level will drop to around 750 metres where it will remain through the day. Showers, falling as snow above around 700 metres, during the period.

Comments

Some fresh windslab will be deposited in sheltered areas, mainly on North through East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. This will fall almost exclusively on moist bare ground and deposits are not expected to present an avalanche hazard. On Wednesday rain is expected at all levels and this new snow will melt.
