


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 20/12/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New accumulations of light snow deposits are not expected to be significant and should not present an avalanche hazard. Avalanche reports will not be issued for this area today. Greatest accumulations will be on North-East to South-East aspects above 800 metres. Storm force winds and white out conditions can be expected.



Forecast Weather Influences

Blustery showers, continuing tonight these, briefly heavy at times but passing quickly, falling as snow above 700 metres. Wednesday morning snow showers turning to more persistent rain as a warm front moves East and the freezing level rises above the summits. Rain will be heavy at times accompanied by Westerly gales at lower levels and severe gales on the tops.

Comments

Westerly gales at lower levels and severe gales over the high summits. The new recent snow cover is expected to thaw and diminish.
