



Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Wednesday 20/12/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

There will be a trace of fresh snow above 600 metres which will rapidly thaw as the freezing level rises above the summits by mid-morning. The old patches of snow will start to soften but will remain well bonded and stable. These patches will be found in mainly wind sheltered locations on North-West through North to East aspects above 950 metres. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Limited overnight snowfall above 600 metres, turning to light rain during the day, as the freezing level rises over the summits. Winds will be fresh, mostly West-North-Westerly.

Old snow firm and icy today. Staying unsettled. Thawing on Wednesday, turning colder on Thursday night.
