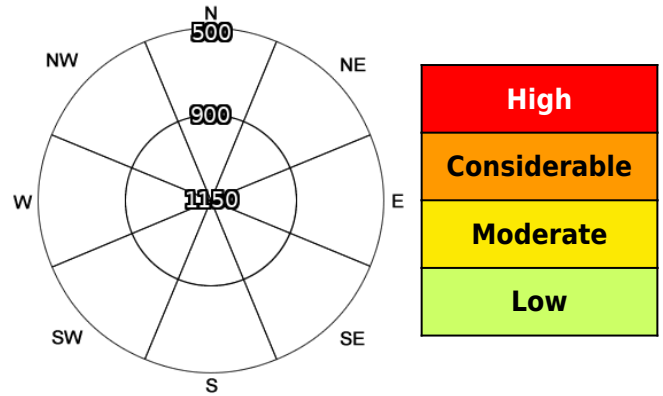


Avalanche Hazard Forecast for Thursday 21/12/2023

Avalanche Problems

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New snow accumulations are not expected to be deep or extensive and will not be significant enough for an avalanche hazard.



Forecast Weather Influences

Winds will be severe gale to storm force, initially from the West, then veering West-North-Westerly from early morning onwards. Further heavy rain this evening continuing overnight. The rain clearing to occasional showers by the morning, with precipitation turning to light snow mainly above 900 metres and then down to 500 metres by early evening.

Winds will be severe gale to storm force; initially from the West then veering to WNW direction from early morning onwards.
