

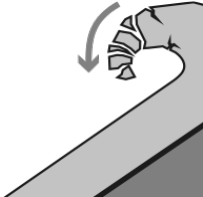

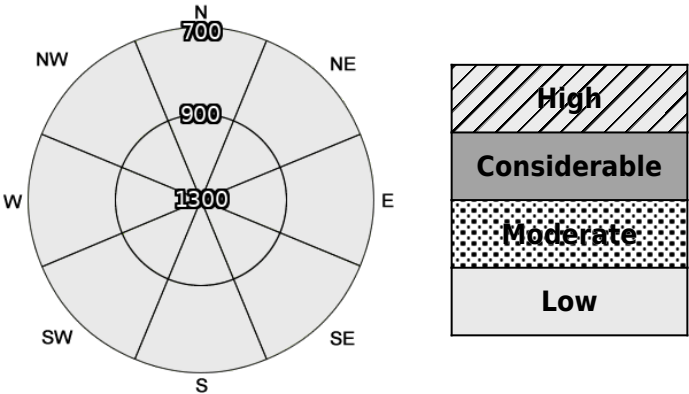
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Isolated accumulations of windslab will build in wind sheltered locations on North through East to South aspects above 900m. Areas most affected will be gully tops and steep corrie headwalls. These accumulations are expected to be shallow and generally avoidable. Fragile cornices will develop on the same aspects. Elsewhere the remaining snow patches will remain hard/icy and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Low.



Forecast Weather Influences

Gale to storm force West-North-West winds will continue. Frequent snow showers. The freezing level will fluctuate around 600 - 800m.

Comments

Windy - as Storm Pia passes over Scotland. Winds easing into the weekend but the freezing level rises to above the summits on Saturday afternoon.
