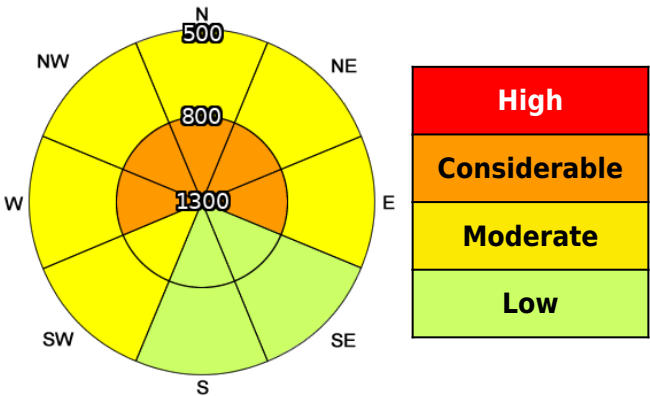

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Drifting snow with further snowfall will develop unstable windslab on mostly Northerly to Easterly aspects above 800m where avalanches are likely. Instabilities will persist on SW to NW aspects above 800m. In these areas Coire back walls, gullies and crag aprons will be most affected. Below this level and above 500m instabilities will persist on SW through N to E facing wind sheltered areas such as steep banks and gullies. Cornices will be unstable. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable



Forecast Weather Influences

Snow showers throughout the forecast period on gale to storm force South-Westerly winds. The freezing level will fluctuate between 1000 and 800 metres.
