




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Moderately bonded windslab will be present in wind sheltered locations on West through North to East aspects above 600 metres with moderately to weakly bonded accumulations above 800 metres. Fragile cornices will have formed. Moderately bonded windslab will be encountered above 800 metres in wind sheltered locations on South-East to South-West aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Considerable.



Forecast Weather Influences

Light to moderate snowfall on fresh to strong South-Westerly winds. Freezing level 700 metres overnight, rising slowly to 800 metres by early afternoon.
