




Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

A partial consolidation of yesterdays snowpack is expected at first. New accumulations of moderately bonded windslab will also start to develop in wind sheltered locations. The greatest accumulations will be on North to East aspects mainly above 900 metres with North-West aspects also affected due to some cross loading. Fragile cornices will develop above these aspects. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Fluctuating freezing levels but generally at around 900 metres for most of the period. Strong, South-Westerly winds and frequent showers these falling as snow mainly above 700 metres.

Comments

A calmer day is in prospect but some new windslab development is also expected mostly above 900 metres.
