



##### Avalanche Problems




Wind Slab

##### Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Redistribution of existing soft snow combined with fresh snow will lead to windslab development through the day. Areas most affected will be steep wind sheltered locations, such as gullies and coire rims with South-West to North-West aspects above 750 metres. Cornices will begin to develop above these aspects. Wind exposed slopes will be scoured and stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



##### Forecast Weather Influences

After a dry morning showers from midday will initially be snow above 300 metres turning to rain below 600 metres by the end of the afternoon. After a calm night Easterly winds will increase to become Gale force for most of the day. The freezing level will be around 400 metres rising through the afternoon.
