

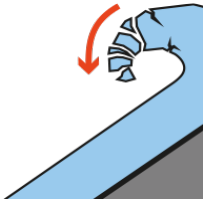

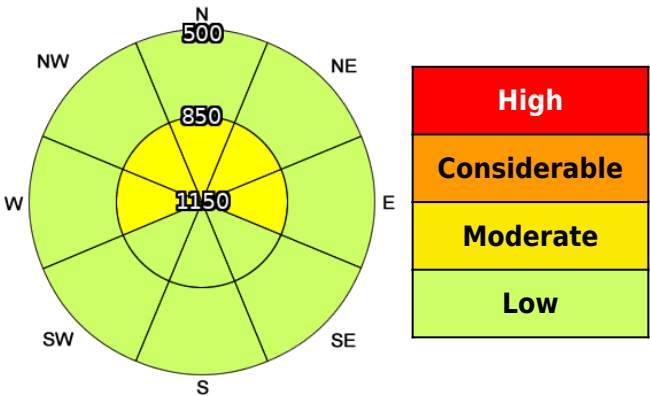
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

Poorly bonded windslab will remain in wind sheltered locations mostly on West through North to North-Easterly aspects above 850 metres. Areas particularly affected will be steeper slopes, sheltered gullies and steep coire headwalls. Also, cornices on similar aspects will be fragile. Windward slopes will be scoured and more stable. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

The freezing level will become around 950 metres. The gale force East-South-Easterly winds will slowly ease through the period becoming Easterly, fresh then moderate. Isolated showers falling as snow mainly above 800 metres.
