

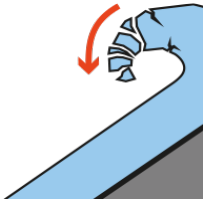

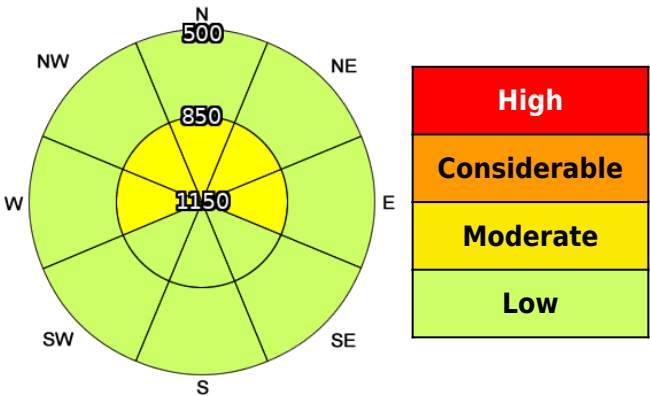
Wind Slab

Forecast Snow Stability & Avalanche Hazard

New shallow accumulations of unstable windslab will form in wind sheltered areas mostly on North-West to North-East aspects above 850 metres. Instabilities will also remain in older deposits of poorly bonded windslab that exist on West and Easterly aspects above 850 metres. Steeper slopes, sheltered gullies and steep coire headwalls will be particularly affected. Cornices on similar aspects will also be fragile. The avalanche hazard will be Moderate.



Forecast Weather Influences

Overnight, the light East-South-Easterly winds will veer and strengthen becoming fresh South-South-Westerly in direction. The freezing level will lower to around 800 metres. Early in the morning showers will fall as snow mainly above 650 metres.
